





What is Resilience?

The capacity to withstand loss, the capacity to prevent a loss from occurring in the first place, and the capacity to recover from a loss if it occurs

- The magnitude of shock that **the system can absorb** and remain in a given state
- The degree to which the system is capable of selforganization
- The degree to which the system can build capacity for learning and adaptation

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




